We are continuing to have a huge focus on number formation for the rest of the term. **The expected standard for Year One children is that they should be able to form their numbers correctly, starting and finishing at the correct place and with no reversals.** We would be grateful if you continue to practise these at home. We are also having a strong focus on writing sentences and captions, thinking about capital letters and full stops to demarcate sentences. Perhaps children could write some captions or sentences at home about The Christmas Story, about how Christmas is celebrated or about what they would like for Christmas– we would love to share these in school!

If you have any versions of The Christmas Story at home that we could share in school we will be continuing to compare and contrast these stories over the coming week in our Story Time sessions.
