They then worked in groups of five to cut, mix, shake and knead! Finally the children enjoyed sampling their meal, they talked about what ingredients they liked and what they didn't like as much. Homework:

This term our topic is 'We Are Chefs' The homework overview for this topic is on the reverse of this letter. There are dates attached to specific tasks as these will link directly with the work we will be doing in class.

English:

Children quickly settled into their new English groups this week. As last term the children will bring home weekly spellings, their books will be allocated on Bug Club every Friday for children to read at home.



Next Week:

In Maths we will begin exploring addition and subtraction to 20, using a range of methods including counting on and back and using number lines, they will also be exploring the relationship between addition and subtraction. For example if $16+4=20$ then $20-16=4$ and $20-4=16$. Continuing the theme of healthy eating children will be looking at a range of plants and thinking about which part of the plant is edible eg. the root, the seeds, the leaves etc. In History, children will begin looking at kitchens past and present, looking at similarities and differences and talking about changes over time. In P.E we will begin composing a 'pizza' dance, children will work individually, in pairs and as a class to respond to music through movement and to link together a range of movements! In Art we will be exploring the life and work of Andy Warhol. You may want to explore some of his images at home, in particular the famous 'Soup Can' image as we will be looking carefully at these images and recreating them in class using a range of media. You may even want to encourage your child to draw a soup can from observation at home, looking carefully at the label and packaging to include as much detail as possible!
