What we have been up to this week?

It has been a very exciting week for us all in Year 1 as we have introduced our new English focused text 'Lost & Found' which is a wonderful story written by Oliver Jeffers, the same author of 'Here We Are'. Although we have not read much of the story yet, we have been using the clues left in our classroom and some sneaky peeks at a few pages in the text to help us predict what the story plot might be. Perhaps you could share what you think will happen in this story with your grown ups over the weekend.



(Shhhh! If you have this story at home please don't share it with your child just yet! Part of our planning is to build up and deep dive into different parts of the story before we read the story fully).

In History, we have continued to explore how things have changed over time and this week we have looked at doing laundry and how this has changed over time. Can you tell your grown up how people washed their clothes in the past? How is this different to the present day?

This week we have been continuing our super Science lessons learning all about deciduous and evergreen trees. We looked at different leaves and sorted them into deciduous or evergreen based on features.



In PE we used our skills to play agility team games racing against each other to complete the challenge by moving the cones from one hoop to the other in a race against the other teams.
