## What we have been up to this week?

This week we have continued to look at the story 'The Lost Property Office'. We have been introduced to Jonathan Forgetful and learnt that names have a capital letter. We have also created an inventory of an animal of our choice. In History, we have been looking at kitchens of the past, focusing on the vocabulary of "past and present".

This week we have been finding out all about the leaves and seeds of deciduous and evergreen trees. The children have enjoyed completing a leaf and seed sort – matching the seed to its leaf. We have also discussed the signs of autumn and learnt about how, during this season, the daylight starts to reduce and days become shorter and nights longer.



We have been looking at how we can make the colour green in art and that primary colours are a group of colours that can make other colours. The children have enjoyed drawing a leaf and then matching it to its colour.
