<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Mathematics</b></p> <p>Can you complete the following activities? You will need a set of number cards up to 20 and a set of counting objects up to 20 and a number line.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Count in 10's up to 100 and then challenge yourself to count backwards from 100 to 0.</li> <li>Pick 3 random cards and order them from the smallest to the biggest. Repeat several times. Can you pick 3 cards and order them from the biggest to smallest? Use your number line to help.</li> <li>Use your number line to find 2,3 or 4 more than a number. Can you write the equation? Remember to form your numbers correctly and use the correct mathematical symbols - =</li> </ul>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>We Are Healthy</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;">Here are some home learning tasks to support you and your child whilst they are learning at home. These tasks are in line with learning that is/would have been taking place in school.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Our topic is 'We are Kind' and we will be looking at 'Supertato' by Sue Hendra</p>		<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Literacy</b></p> <p>We will be discovering the adventures of 'Supertato' over the following weeks. Can you look at the front cover and talk about what you can see? What type of vegetable is it? Why is he wearing a cape and a mask? Who else do we know that wears similar items of clothing? Can you name any superheroes? What makes them a superhero? What types of powers do they have? Are all superheroes good? Who is your favourite superhero?</p> <div style="text-align: center;">  </div> <p>Phonics lessons will be allocated to your child using their BugClub account. They will be in line with the phonics lessons for the phase your child is in. You will also be allocated two books for your child's current phonic phase. Please read at least three times per week, answering comprehension questions and completing the BugClub challenges!</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>PSED</b></p> <p>Using our prior knowledge from our topic 'We are Real Life Heroes' talk about all the people who help us such as police officers, fire fighters and how they help us. How could you help a friend or family member? How does it feel when we have been kind and helpful? Draw a picture of a time you have been helpful and write a sentence to go with your drawing explaining what you did.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">We are really impressed with all the hard work you are completing at home as part of your homework tasks.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">On this overview are some ideas for learning this week.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Please adapt and support your child as much or little as you feel they need. Work can be completed on paper or practically. <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Fine Motor Skills</b></p> <p>Make your own Supertato! Using the activity sheet in <b>Assignments</b> cut out each piece and stick them together to make Supertato. Remember to hold your scissors correctly and cut carefully along the lines.</p> <div style="text-align: center;">  </div>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Gross Motor Skills</b></p> <p>Practise your throwing and catching skills with the Sevens Ball game challenge in <b>Assignments</b>. Start at 7 and working down to 1, complete each throwing and catching activity in order.</p> <p>If you drop the ball you must start back at 7!</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Expressive Arts and Design</b></p> <p>Take a look at the front cover of 'Supertato'. 		<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Understanding the World</b></p> <p>You will need to complete this activity over a couple of days and will need ice trays and peas (or any vegetables). Put several peas in the ice tray with water and freeze them. Talk about how the water will change to ice because of the temperature in the freezer. When the tray is frozen take out the ice cubes and observe what happens over time. The ice melts because the room temperature is warmer. How can we speed up the melting process to rescue the pea? Add salt and discuss what happens.</p>
