


Reception Online Learning Tasks 19.4.2021

<p style="text-align: center;">Mathematics</p> <p>Can you complete the following activities?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Count in 10's up to 50 and then challenge yourself to count up to 100. Practise your number formation ensuring each number is the correct way round. Write down as many ways as you can to make 10 Can you order a set of random numbers from 0-10? 	<p style="text-align: center;">We Are Kind</p> <p>Here are some home learning tasks to support you and your child whilst they are learning at home. These tasks are in line with learning that is/would have been taking place in school.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Our topic is 'We are Kind' and we will be looking at 'Silly Doggy' by Adam Stower</p>		<p style="text-align: center;">Literacy</p> <p>We are continuing our work based on the story of 'Silly Doggy' by Adam Stower.</p> <p>Have a look through the book at the pictures of the bear. How do you think he is feeling on each picture? How do we know? His facial expression lets us know if he is feeling happy, sad or angry. Look at how we use speech bubbles and have a go at writing your own speech bubble for the bear. You could write 'I am sad' or 'I am cross'.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">PSED</p> <p>This week we will be talking about the importance of staying safe whilst we are walking alongside a road and crossing a road. Have a look at the Dilemma Drop in Assignments and talk about how we stay safe whilst out and about.</p>	<p>We are really impressed with all the hard work you are completing at home as part of your homework tasks.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">On this overview are some ideas for learning this week.</p> <p>Please adapt and support your child as much or little as you feel they need. They will be in line with the phonics lessons for the phase your child is in. You will also be allocated two books for your child's current phonic phase. Please read at least three times per week, answering comprehension questions and completing the BugClub challenges!</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Fine Motor Skills/Expressive Arts and Design</p> <p>Using the template in Assignments can you make your own bear face?</p> <p>Remember to hold your scissors correctly and cut carefully along the lines. Then use glue the pieces together to make a bear face.</p> <p>How is your bear feeling? Is he happy or sad, worried or angry? Can you draw the</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Gross Motor Skills</p> <p>We will be developing our throwing and catching skills this term.</p> <p>Warm up – hop on one foot x 10 then swap feet and repeat. Jump up and down x 20. Jog on the spot for 30 secs then a minute.</p> <p>Activity – Throw a ball in the air and catch with two hands. Remember how it is important to watch when the ball will begin to fall and be ready to catch it. Now repeat with one hand behind your back and the other hand catching the ball. Now swap hands and repeat activity.</p> <p>Cool down – Stretch up to the sky then down to your toes x 5, Breathe in and out slowly x 5</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Understanding the World</p> <p>We will be discovering all about the different animals which we would find in a zoo. Have a look at the interactive map of Chester Zoo and talk to your grown up about the animals you can see. Are they all the same? What makes them different?
