## Remote Learning Information for Parents

We know remote learning can be difficult and depending on your circumstances will vary. This planning sheet is a range of activities that mirror the Year 1 learning in school this week as much as possible. We would suggest a daily Maths, English and Phonics (when possible) and focusing on one or two of the foundation activities each afternoon. Please send any home learning to your class teacher using the home learning selfie email address.

## English: Narrative Story Writing From a picture



This week in Year 1 we are telling stories using only a picture as a stimulus. Using the links below and the story planner (uploaded to Teams) can you write a short story for each picture. You could choose a different picture each day. Think about which part of the story the picture depicts – is this the beginning, middle or end of the story? We will be focusing on creating stories with a clear narrative – with an opening/start of the story introducing any characters and setting the scene, building up to a problem in the story, explaining what the problem in the story is. Finally how is the problem resolved, by who, and what type of ending does this lead to. How are the characters feeling at the end and why. Don't forget it is important to write in full sentences with capital letters and full stops used correctly. You may want to use some other punctuation in your story such as ! or ?. Can you use 'and' to join to sentences? Finally what exciting, descriptive vocabulary can you use to make your story exciting.

### **Phonics**

If your child is isolating for 10-14 days, please contact the school office. Details of your child's phonic phase will be sent to you. You should then access the appropriate phonic materials on the 'Remote Learning English page' to support your child. We would recommend a short daily phonic session, revising the phoneme grapheme correspondence using the appropriate phase resources and revision of tricky words/common exception words. Children should be able to read and spell the words in the phonic phase they are working in. Other daily phonic activities could include online Bug Club reading, online Bug Club phonic games and reading and writing captions using the sounds and tricky words in their phase.

### Maths

In school we use Big Maths as our teaching scheme. Some resources can be found on our Remote Learning Maths page. If your child is isolating for 10-14 days, please contact the school office and they will inform you what CLIC level your child is working on and send you more specific CLIC Home Learning tasks appropriate for your child.

### Computing 1

We have been using the computers to make a power point presentation about Africa. Using Microsoft power point (online version available with your TEAMS account) can you create a page all about Kenya. Can you add some text and a picture? You can search on Google for some images, but please remember to have a grown up close by and remember are SMART internet rules.

### Geography 1

Can you remember what life is like in Kenya? Compare life in Kenya to life in Crosby. Can you write 3 things that are similar and 3 differences between Kenya and Crosby?

### Science 1

Recap on your knowledge about different types of animals from this term. Using the animal sheet (See Teams) or using toy animals you may have at home – can you sort them into categories by the type of animal they are. Can you talk or write about why they are in each category e.g. It is a bird because it has wings and a beak.

### Art

### Computing

As part of our power point presentation we need to compare life in Crosby/England to life in Kenya.  
  
Can you use the camera app on your home device to take some photographs around your home/garden.  
  
Can you add these to a power point slide and add some text to share information about your home/life in Crosby.

### Geography 2

What can you find out about Ghana another country in Africa? Where is it located? What is the climate? Do people live in build up cities or remote villages in Ghana?  
  
Can you draw or write to share what you have found out about Ghana.

### Science 2

Can you remember the 4 different seasons we have learnt about this year? What order do the seasons occur?  
  
Use the ppt (see Teams) to find out about key features of the summer season.  
  
Can you compare summer to another season. What things do you notice are different or the same? Can you draw and label a picture of the things you will see in summer?
