

What's New In Year 2



Week Beginning- Monday 13th September.

All the details from this week-

Another great week in Year 2! We have continued using the book 'We Are Here' to inspire and stimulate writing opportunities. The book has really got us thinking about the amazing world where we live. In Maths, the children have made and read tally charts, as well as beginning to look at money (using coins to make different amounts). We have begun looking at some different habitats, starting with the Arctic. The children have discovered a lot of interesting facts about Polar Bears (did you know only female polar bears hibernate?). The bear theme continued in our Art lesson, with the children first looking at how bears have been depicted in paintings and drawings through history before following a tutorial showing them how to draw a bear. The children certainly enjoyed this activity and it resulted in some fantastic drawings! All the children have now completed their Road Safety sessions – these focused on how to cross the road safely, including crossing on a corner and between parked cars. Please ask your child to show you what they have learnt whilst you are out and about.

Plastic Containers for Bear Sculptures

Later in the term the children will be designing and creating their own 3D sculptures of bears. To help with this, it would be great if you could send in some plastic containers that the children can use as the body of the bear. Ideal containers are one pint plastic milk bottles, 500ml plastic drink bottles, large yoghurt pots or any other similar size and shaped containers. If you could send any of these containers in next week they can then be put into 'quarantine' to be used later in our Art lessons. Many thanks!
