All the details from this week

We have started looking at a new book in Literacy this week called 'Leaf', a story about a 'strange white creature' that ends up stranded in an alien habitat. We have used the first few pages to help us create noun phrases and look at how these improve our story writing by adding greater detail. This is a key writing skill in Year 2 and one that we will continue to revisit. In Maths, we have looked at identifying a quarter and a third of shapes, recognising the parts must be equal. In Science we have now looked at sloths and how their habitat (rainforest) provides for all their needs. We found lots of interesting facts about this very slow-moving animal (like why a sloth visits the ground!!).



Bug Club Books



For children on the phonics programme (any children on Turquoise band or above have completed the programme) it is really important that the children are accessing their Bug Club account regularly as the books that have been assigned each week reinforce the phonics taught in class. There should be two books and a selection of games to complete. This will ensure that the children become confident with the graphemes taught that week and get them ready for the next phase of the programme. For children who have completed the phonics programme, they will have been assigned a selection of books at the relevant level to read.

Can you carry out some research about an animal or plant that lives in a rainforest and present your findings to your class? Maybe you could show the information in a poster, mind map or even a PowerPoint! Practise at home with your family ready to share in school. You can either bring into school or email any resources you want to use for the presentation.
