Topic Information:

Within Nursery we carry out our curriculum through a variety of different topics. Some topics may only be a week long, while others will last a whole half term. The length of each topic will depend heavily on the interests of the children and the number of activities which relate to the topic.

Our topic this half term is 'We are Special'. During the first weeks we will focus upon finding out about ourselves, our friends and our family. We will learn the names for the different parts of our body, discover our eye and hair colour and talk about our different skin colours. You may like to discuss such features with your child. Maybe you could encourage your child to look at and study themselves in the mirror, looking at different features. You could discuss what makes them unique. Thank you.
