

Reception Weekly News

What a lovely first full week we have had. The children have completed their first two full days in Reception and they are really settling in nicely to their new classes.

This week we have been learning our school Golden Rules. We read a lovely story about a little girl called Eva who was new to her school and was learning her class teacher's new rules. The children were able to talk about why school rules are important and staff emphasised that rules are there to keep us all safe. We shared our Golden Rules poster with the children. At the weekend why not ask your child to see if they can remember any of the school rules? There is a picture below that can act as a prompt.



We have also been meeting our Class Bears and DeeDee our PSHE mascot. The children now know that they can give the class bear a cuddle should they be feeling upset and that DeeDee is going to help us when we are doing a PSHE focus to make a good decision when she is faced with a dilemma.

We have also been drawing self portraits and these are being displayed so that all children have a piece of work up in the classroom that they can be proud of.

Thank you for the parental feedback about drops offs and collections. The majority of feedback has been positive. In order to ensure that children safely enter the building please can we ask that once a child has started walking up the ramp that you exit the playground via the one way system. We appreciate it is nice to wave children into the school building but this is causing a bottle neck at the end of the ramp and therefore is becoming unsafe for children still coming in. When we dismiss children at the end of the school day, please can we ask that you only wave when your child is at the front of the line. We are still familiarising ourselves with parents and this makes it easier to spot where you are standing and speeds up the process- particularly as we are drawing into the winter months.
