





In class this week we have been looking at our families, the similarities and differences. Important Information

Please ensure that your child comes to school with a named and full water bottle. As a Healthy School can we ask that these are only filled with water and not juice.

Children are offered milk during the day with snack and they also have the option of fruit juice or water at lunch time.

We have received a number of emails detailing appointments or informing us of illness. Please let Miss Edwards in the school office know any attendance related information via a phone call. As part of our Safeguarding policy we complete first day response calls or home visits and therefore it is vital that Miss Edwards has the up to date information. Miss Edwards will then inform class teachers either by phone or email so that parents don't have to. Thank you.

Prior to the end of the school day all children are offered the opportunity to go to the toilet this is because we are unable to let children come back into school after they have been dismissed. This is part of our Safeguarding Policy as all doors to school are open at that time so children could leave through another exit and we do not have the staff to monitor children in the school building. If your child often needs the toilet on the way home please remind them that they need to go to the toilet before they leave school as they will not be able to re-enter the building. Thank you 😊
