Please note that the lunches are just a taster as they don't have long to eat their lunch. Therefore they may require something extra to eat when they get home.

From Thursday all children will be in full time 8:45am-3:25pm.

Please can we ask that at drop off and collection times that only **one** parent drops off and collects and you stand back from the school building. It is much safer for children to enter and exit the building when they can easily see their teachers. From next week, we will be dismissing children from the Classroom doors. We ask that once your child's class teacher has spotted you and sends your child out to you, that you stay where you are so your child can make their way to you. Please watch your child exit the building and walk to you to ensure they make it to you safely.

Thank you for following our guidelines for entering and exiting school. It really is important in order to ensure the safety of our children and grown ups.

Parent Meetings

Thank you to all those parents who have signed up for a meeting with your child's class teacher. If you have not signed up yet, please call the school office and they will let you know what availability we have.

Meetings are 15 mins per parent. We ask that only one parent attends. Face masks will not be needed as we will ensure social distancing. Please come to the Reception gate on Forefield Lane (where you drop off) and wait on the playground. Your class teacher will come out and get you when they have finished the previous appointment. We ask that no children come to the meetings as it is an opportunity for you to share any information about your child that you think we need to know.

Uniform

Please can you ensure that all uniform is clearly labelled with your child's name. Please label EVERYTHING.
