

Year 1 Remote Learning 11th October 2021

<p>Remote Learning Overview</p> <p>We know remote learning can be difficult and will vary depending on your circumstances.</p> <p>This planning sheet is a range of activities that mirror the Year 1 learning in school this week as much as possible. We would suggest a daily Maths, English and Phonics (when possible) and focusing on one or two of the other activities each afternoon.</p>	<p>English: Autumn fact files</p> <p>Activity 1: Draw an autumnal picture and label the signs of autumn on it e.g. brown leaves, bare branch, etc</p> <p>Activity 2: Write autumn facts using full sentences- what are the signs of autumn? What happens in autumn? Can you use a capital letter, finger spaces and full stops?</p> <p>Activity 3: Write an autumn poem- what noises and sights can you hear and see in autumn e.g.</p> <p>The rustling of a leaf, The blowing of the wind, The pitter patter of the rain, That's how I know it is autumn!</p> <p>Activity 4: Can you make a list of all the autumn colours you can see, try as many names for shades as you can, for example crimson, scarlet, etc.</p> <p>Can you find any information books around your house? What are they about? Can you write instructions to look after a bird?</p>		
<p style="text-align: center;">Maths</p> <p>Can you find two equations that make the same total? The equal sign is a balance, so can you write one on each side of the equals sign. For example, $4+5=8+1$</p> <p>Can you write equations where the answer comes first e.g. $9=8+1$</p>		<p style="text-align: center;">Geography</p> <p>Can you draw special map symbols to go on a key for the rooms in your house? What might represent the kitchen? Draw a symbol that can be easily recognised and tell everyone which room is which.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Science</p> <p>The senses- touch. Can you describe different items from around the house? How do they feel? Use vocabulary such as hard, soft, rough, smooth to describe. Can you sort the objects?</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">PE</p> <p>Remember to keep exercising if you can! We are practising skipping with a rope in school this week and also throwing a ball, letting it bounce and then hitting it with our hands. Can you throw a ball against a wall and hit it with your hand when it comes back to you? Can you throw overarm? Aim for a target.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Music</p> <p>Can you make an autumn soundscape using found materials e.g. conkers, rustling leaves, etc</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">PSHE</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Friendship- Write the qualities of a good friend and why.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Art</p> <p>Make an autumn art palette with all of the colours of autumn stuck onto it e.g. how many shades of red can you find in nature?</p>
