Reception Weekly News

This week we have continued our investigation into autumn, sorting objects that we would find in autumn and the finale of the week our Harvest Assembly. Mrs Haney talked about Harvest and we were able to show our learning about autumn. Each class had prepared a song which we performed in front of the other classes.

In Maths we have been exploring '2' looking at how it can be made 1+1 and 2+0 and also where it comes on the number line. We have begun subitising numbers, spotting an arrangement of objects or a pattern of 2 or 1, aiming to recognise the amount 1 or 2 quickly.

The Gingerbread Man story is now coming to an end. This week, we used pictures to sequence the story correctly and also made a map of the route that the Gingerbread Man took to travel from the bakery to the river. The children then began recording other journeys they take, from school to home or to the park.

Class 2 were very lucky with the weather for the first Forest School session and it was a great success. The children really enjoyed themselves exploring and investigating the Forrest School area and showed perseverance in a new environment.
