Write the facts using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.</b></p> <p><b>Activity 2- Cat facts- do the same as Activity 1 but write all about cats- what can they do that is special? What do they eat? What do they need? Why do they have whiskers? Can you use any special or unusual words in your sentences?</b></p> <p><b>Activity 3- Select an animal of your own choice to find out about and make a fact file of- use pictures and writing to get the information across. Can you label the animal too?</b></p>		
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Maths</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;">Teen numbers.</p> <p>What teen numbers do you know? Can you write them correctly? Can you make equations to make different teen numbers? Choose one e.g. 14. How many different ways can you make it? Use add and subtract. Maybe 14 counters or shells or objects will help. Investigate a ten number each day.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">History</p> <p>Can you find out anything about the history of where you live? What did Crosby used to be like? How do you know? Who could you ask? What could you look at? What would help us to find out about the past and what it was like in different places? Wrote down or draw what you find out.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Geography</p> <p>Find out about the place where you live- is it Crosby, Waterloo, Litherland, Bootle, Thornton or somewhere else? Is it a village? What city or town is it part of? Look at maps and see if you can find any facts about the place where you live. Can you find it on a map of England?</p> <p>Can you find out about your town? Find out where in Liverpool it is, can you find it on a map of Liverpool?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Science</p> <p>Materials- explore the materials around your house- brick, wood, cotton, rubber, etc. What can you find? Can you describe them using words like shiny or dull, rough/smooth, bendy/rigid, etc. Sort them and make a table to show what you find.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">PE</p> <p><b>Can you dodge and tag? Play dodging games e.g. dodge ball, tag, etc.</b></p> <p>What yoga poses can you remember from school? Can you do the butterfly? The other poses are – mountain, tree, moon, child's pose, shooting star and cobra. See if you can teach an adult about these poses and demonstrate. Can you do any yoga breathing? Can you find songs that are fast and slow?
