

# Year 1 Remote Learning 22nd November 2021

<p><b>Remote Learning Overview</b></p> <p>We know remote learning can be difficult and will vary depending on your circumstances.</p> <p>This planning sheet is a range of activities that mirror the Year 1 learning in school this week as much as possible. We would suggest a daily Maths, English and Phonics (when possible) and focusing on one or two of the other activities each afternoon.</p>	<p><b>English: Nibbles</b> watch the story here- <a href="https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=DtcaeUUfh8U">https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=DtcaeUUfh8U</a></p> <p><b>Activity 1-</b> choose your favourite book and copy the cover e.g. the very Hungry Caterpillar. Remember the story of Nibbles- the book monster who invades other stories by eating his way into them. What would happen if Nibbles went into your favourite story? For example- Nibbles went to see the caterpillar. He ate the leaf and the fruit. Write about the trouble that Nibbles would cause in your favourite story.</p> <p>Activity 2- Make a story map of the story of Nibbles using pictures- order the story. Which other stories did he go into? IN what order? What did he eat in each story? Retell the story in your own words.</p> <p>Activity 3- rewrite the story of Nibbles. You might like to do this in stages or chapters or sections. Write about the places he went, what he did and what happened.</p> <p>Activity 4- a diary for Nibbles. What will he write? You must be Nibbles and write as 'I'. an example of this is 'I am a book monster called Nibbles. I love to eat books and go into the stories inside. You will never believe what happened when I went to see...'</p>		
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Maths</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;">Teen numbers.</p> <p>What teen numbers do you know? Can you write them correctly? Can you make equations to make different teen numbers? Choose one e.g. 14. How many different ways can you make it? Use add and subtract. Maybe 14 counters or shells or objects will help. Investigate a ten number each day.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">History</p> <p>Can you find out anything about the history of where you live? What did Crosby used to be like? How do you know? Who could you ask? What could you look at? What would help us to find out about the past and what it was like in different places? Wrote down or draw what you find out.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Geography</p> <p>Find out about the place where you live- is it Crosby, Waterloo, Litherland, Bootle, Thornton or somewhere else? Is it a village? What city or town is it part of? Look at maps and see if you can find any facts about the place where you live. Can you find it on a map of England?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Science</p> <p>Materials- what is made of glass? How is glass made? Where does it come from? Look for glass in your house. <p style="text-align: center;">PE</p> <p>Can you move backwards? Can you be light on your feet and look where you are going over each shoulder?</p> <p>What yoga poses can you remember from school? Can you do the butterfly? The other poses are – mountain, tree, moon, child’s pose, shooting star and cobra. See if you can teach an adult about these poses and demonstrate. Can you do any yoga breathing?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Music</p> <p>Can you listen to some music and tap the pulse, the steady beat, of the music? Can you find songs that are fast and slow? Judge them by how fast the pulse of the music is.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">PSHE</p> <p><b>What does it mean to treat someone fairly? Can you write down or talk about how we can be fair to other- what is fair and what would be unfair? How could you treat people who are unfair to you? What would you say to them?</b></p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Art</p> <p>Can you make a model of Nibbles? Use what you can find around the house and see how detailed you can make it.</p>
