In History the children answered their own questions about the Great Fire of London, understanding what makes a reliable source of information. Using the website <https://www.fireoflondon.org.uk/browse-the-collection/> the children searched for appropriate artefacts to find appropriate information to answer their questions. The children have also enjoyed continuing to develop their Great Fire of London dance in our PE lessons. They have also been developing skills needed for a variety of net games; this week it was all about striking a ball with the palm of the hand and returning the ball over cones – skills needed for tennis etc. **(N.B. Phonics Screener

Many children are now whole word reading as they become more confident readers. This however is resulting in children mis-reading some words and therefore not understanding the text they are reading. If your child does this at home please encourage them to sound out the word using their phonics. This is also the way they should tackle the phonic screener particularly as the words are stand alone and not in any context. When practising the real and nonsense words attached, please use this method. Thanks for your support.
