Using Google Maps show your child the 'Earth' identifying the sea and land. Discuss that we live in a local area called Crosby and then zoom in on our area. Can your child identify any familiar landmarks? The beach? Then zoom in to the school area, identify the infants and the juniors, where they live, the park and also the church opposite the school. Once you are able you could go on a walk around the school identifying these landmarks in our local area.</p> <p><b>Key Vocabulary</b> local, landmarks</p>
