Exploring using materials

With our focus on London we would like you to use different materials to recreate the skyline of London. Looking at the different shapes and heights the building are, and to help aid recognition of the landmarks of London.

You could try;

Using different lines thick, thin, straight, diagonal and different media black pen or pencil to recreate the London skyline.

Using paint to create a shadow outline.

Using charcoal or pastels (if you have them!)

Using sheets or large material to 'Art Attack' a skyline on the floor!!

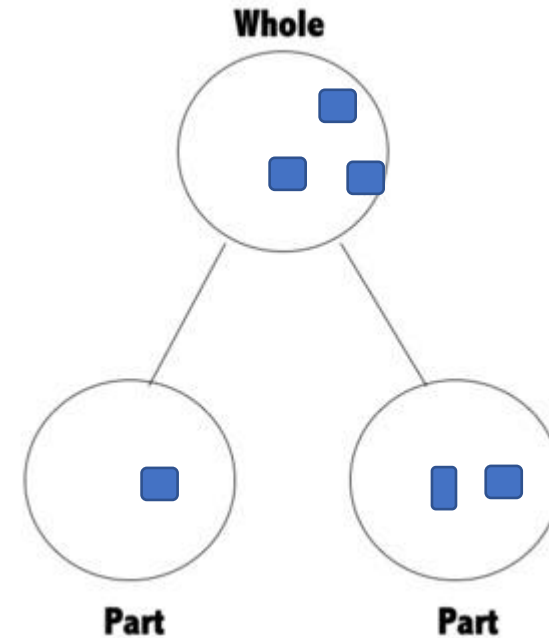


Maths
